3 TANZANIA HIGHLIGHTS IN 4 DAYS

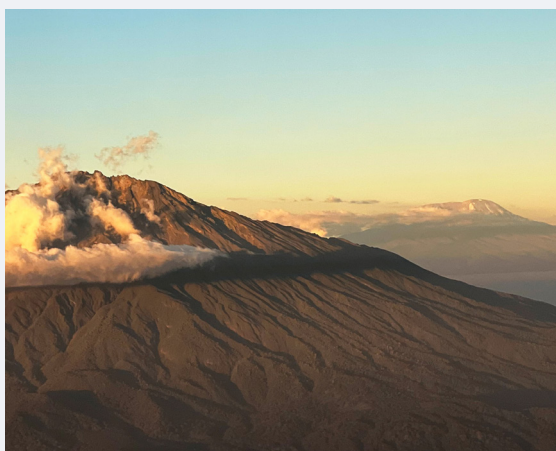
Discover Tarangire National Park, Lake Manyara and Ngorongoro Crater on a private 4-day safari from Arusha in a 4 x 4 safari landcruiser. Spot a variety of animals including the famous Big 5 (lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant and rhino), enjoy the scenic landscapes and diverse bird species such as ostriches, secretary birds, flamingos and herons, and explore the incredible Ngorongoro Crater with its 600-meter-high walls, considered one of the eight natural wonders of the world.

We provide tents, mattresses, pillows, chairs and tables; however, we recommend that you bring your own sleeping bag. You can also rent it from us at a reasonable price. Camping in public campgrounds is a cost-effective alternative to lodge accommodation. In addition to a professional English-speaking guide, you will be accompanied by a private chef who will take care of your meals and well-being and will also set up your tents on arrival at the camps.

4 DAYS CAMPING SAFARI ITINERARY

Experience the chorus of animals and birds up close, enjoy your lunch surrounded by natural beauty and meet the diverse wildlife of Ngorongoro Crater on a sunrise game drive.

Contact our safari experts for advice or changes to our 4 day camping safari. As with all our Tanzania safaris, this itinerary can be adjusted to include additional days, other parks or be upgraded to overnight lodge accommodation.



DAY 1 | ARRIVAL

We will meet either at Kilimanjaro International / Arusha Airport or pick you up at your current location in Arusha. Let 's come together for a welcome reception, safari briefing and dinner. Depending on your time of arrival there is maybe time for a little tour in and around Arusha, the Safari capital of Tanzania.

ACCOMMODATION: Planet Lodge Arusha (or similar)

DAY 2 | TARANGIRE NAT. PARK

After an early breakfast the tour departs with a quick stop for any personal last minute purchases before heading off towards your first national park in Tanzania, the beautiful Tarangire. The park is known for its large number of elephants, but wildebeest, zebra, impala, giraffe, eland and buffalo are also widely found.

You will enjoy a picnic lunch in the park and after another afternoon game drive we will go to Mto wa Mbu for dinner and overnight.

ACCOMMODATION: Migombani Campsite (or similar)



4 DAYS CAMPING SAFARI ITINERARY



DAY 3 | LAKE MANYARA NAT. PARK

Today 's tour will be to Lake Manyara. This park offers stunning views and a large variety of habitats. Acacia woodlands, water forests, baobab strewn cliffs, algae-streaked hot springs, swamps and the lake itself. And thanks to this the small park is able to support a large number of animal species and incredible bird life.

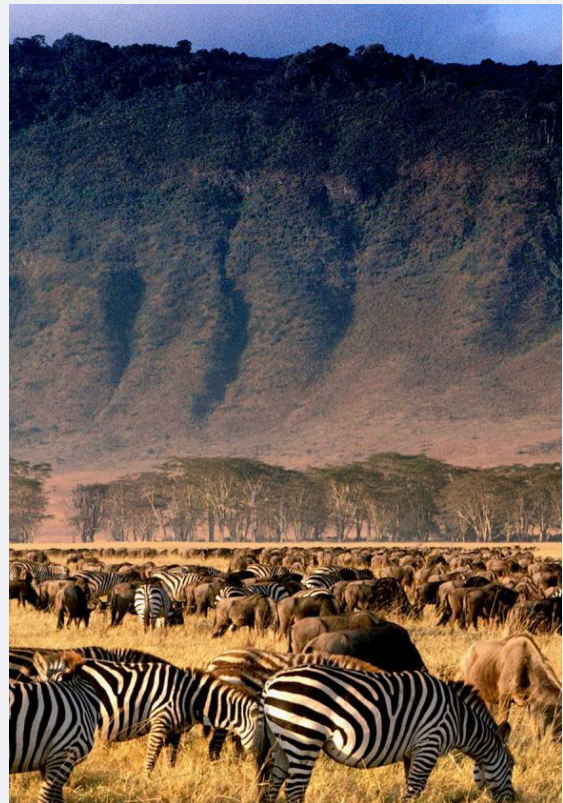
Manyara is also widely renowned for its tree climbing lions.

We will have a picnic lunch at the park and in the later afternoon we drive further towards Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

ACCOMMODATION: Simba A Campsite (or similar)

DAY 4 | NGORONGORO CRATER

After a very early breakfast, we will descend over 600 meters into the crater to view the spectacular wildlife. Supported by a year round water supply, the Ngorongoro conservation Area supports a vast variety of animals, which include herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo and giant African elephants. Another big draw card to this picturesque national park, is its dense population of predators, which include lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs and the ever-elusive leopard. A large number of flamingos and other water birds can usually be seen here, too. We will have a picnic lunch in the park and in the afternoon we drive back to Arusha for airport drop off. Additional accommodation and dinner in Arusha can be included upon request (extra cost).
